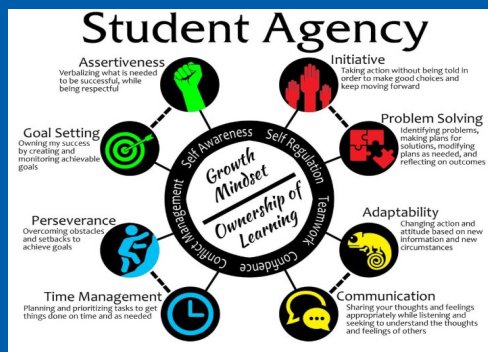
GRADE LEVEL HIGHLIGHTS
